

- Kitchener is home to Google's largest office in Canada
- Additional office space under construction in Kitchener will add 300,000 sq.ft. of space
- In 2020 Google had 1,000 employees in Kitchener-Waterloo and expect that the number of employees will exceed 3,000 by the end of 2022

- Airport expansion approved and under construction




PROVINCE INVESTS IN KITCHENER GO TRANSIT

- Planned electrification of the GO line will reduce commute times along the Kitchener Union Station Route to 90 minutes
- Metrolinx reports 2-way all-day GO service to Kitchener as early as 2025
- GO Train arrives in downtown Kitchener, one block away from TFK Tower




REGIONAL AIRPORT EXPANSION








PRICES KEEP RISING


- Over the past 6 years the average home value has more than doubled with an average increase of \$75,000 year over year
